The provision of trained and prepared Operational Analysts (OA) and Scientific Advisors (SCIAD) held ready to deploy as embedded advisors to Operational Commanders and Headquarters (HQ)





### **Graduated Readiness**



Holding sufficient numbers of Suitably Qualified and Experienced staff at defined states of notice to move (NTM) to meet military operational requirements

High Readiness 30 days NTM Low Readiness 90 days NTM **Pipeline**




